

### Love Your Neighbor Intentionally

Valentines is wrapped in the language of love. Hearts, cards, gifts, flowers, and chocolates remind us to express affection to the people closest to us. But as followers of Christ, this holiday also invites us to reflect on a deeper, wider calling: loving our neighbors intentionally. Philippians 2:4 says, *"Everyone should look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others."*

Loving our neighbor intentionally begins with a shift in focus. In a world that encourages us to prioritize our own schedules, preferences, and needs, Paul calls believers to turn their attention outward. This doesn't mean we ignore our own responsibilities, but it does mean being aware of the people God has placed around us and asking how we might reflect Christ's love to them.

Intentional love requires attentiveness. It notices the neighbor who may be lonely, the coworker who seems overwhelmed, the church member who could use encouragement. Often, loving others starts with something simple: listening without distraction, offering a prayer, or showing kindness in a small but meaningful way.

Lastly, intentional love requires courage, too. Sometimes loving our neighbor means crossing boundaries of comfort—reaching out to someone different from us, forgiving someone who has hurt us, or listening without trying to fix or judge. Jesus modeled this kind of love again and again, choosing compassion over convenience and mercy over distance.

As a church family, imagine the impact if each of us committed this month to loving one neighbor *intentionally*. Not perfectly. Not loudly. Just faithfully. What if our community became known not just for what we believe, but for how deeply we care?

This February, may our love be more than words. May it be visible, thoughtful, and rooted in Christlike humility—loving our neighbors intentionally, for God's glory. Prayerfully ask God to open our eyes to the neighbors He has placed in our path and to give us willing hearts to love them well.






