FROM THE PASTOR...

3 Things to Pray for Those We Love

February is the month that we think about and celebrate "love". We get our loved ones gifts, chocolates, flowers, and cards. But what about the gift of prayer? It's probably not the first gift you thought about giving to those special people in your life, but it should be! Let's look to Paul's example in Ephesians 3 to see three amazing things we should pray for those we love.

Power

First, Paul prayed that the believers in Ephesus would be strengthened by God's power through His Spirit. How silly and foolish we are when we try to live this life apart from the incredible strength that is found in the Lord. By relying upon the Lord and depending on Him for our strength, God pours into us from the riches of His glory! What a wonderful thing to pray for those close to us!

For the Messiah to Dwell in Your Heart

At first, this part of the prayer may seem unusual because Jesus already dwells in believers' hearts. But Paul is not referring to the initial indwelling of Jesus by His Spirit that we receive upon our conversion. Instead, Paul is praying that the believers, through the strength of the Lord, would live their lives in accordance to God's will. When we live contrary to God's will and His Word there is conviction in our life and an internal struggle between our old sin nature and the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit. When we walk with the Lord, obeying His Word and listening to the Holy Spirit, then Christ dwells in our hearts. Essentially, Paul is praying for their sanctification, that they would be more like Christ, growing in our walk with Him. We should always be praying that our loved ones are growing in their faith and walk with the Lord.

A Deeper Understanding of God's Love

Lastly, Paul prays that they would "be able to comprehend...what is the length and width, height and depth of God's love, and to know the Messiah's love that surpasses knowledge, so you may be filled with all the fullness of God"! What a prayer! How vast is our God's love? Beyond measure! His love is so amazing that we cannot fully or completely understand it. But if we were able to grow in our understanding, to see a little more clearly just how much God loves us, how wonderful that would be!

So, this year, get your loved ones those stuffed animals, sweets, and cards. But also give them something even better, pray that they would be strengthened in the Lord, growing in their walk with Him, and that they would understand a little

more just how much God loves us!





VISION STATEMENT

Helping Hands Ministry's vision is to eliminate all physical and spiritual poverty in East Bell County.

MISSION STATEMENT

Helping Hands Ministry cultivates an environment in which individuals and families are empowered to work out of systemic poverty and toward wholeness, through ministries of relief, development, and advocacy.

HISTORY

Helping Hands Ministry was founded in 1995 by the Belton Ministers' Fellowship, an ecumenical gathering of local ministers, to serve the Belton community with a centralized food pantry. In the beginning, individuals from several local churches volunteered their time to serve 30 families in the basement of First United Methodist Church of Belton. The pantry later moved to First Christian Church in Belton, then eventually relocated to a house at 1009 West Avenue D. In November 2008, Helping Hands Ministry moved to its current location at 2210 Holland Road.

Today, Helping Hands Ministry continues to be supported by 30 local churches of many denominations. Each month, Helping Hands Ministry provides support to over 2,600 of our neighbors through the weekly commitment of more than 85 volunteers and staff.




